### BADGES

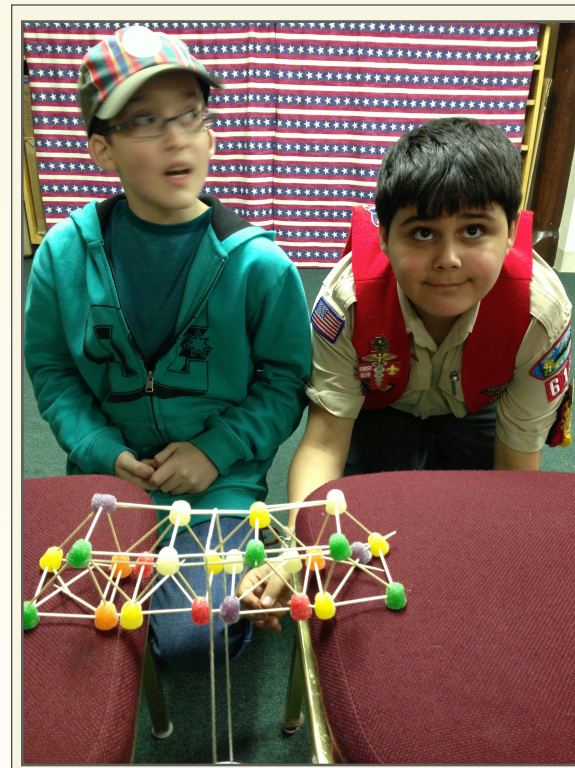
Boys thrive when they are recognized for their efforts. In Cub Scouts we do this through awards such as those they receive tonight.
